## **The Nordic standard form contracts' preparedness for handling external disturbances and price spikes**

For the last months, prices of building materials and building raw materials have skyrocketed, caused by Russia's invasion in Ukraine and the COVID-19 pandemic. It is also expected that the current and forthcoming energy crisis will affect material prices in the near future. In this seminar, the speakers will ask how the Nordic standard form construction contracts (AB 04/ABT 06 in Sweden, AB 18 in Denmark, NS 8405–8407 in Norway, YSE 1998 in Finland, and ÍST 30 in Iceland) deal with these situations, and discuss whether changes would be beneficial. The issue cuts to the core of fair distribution of risks in construction law. Is there Nordic consensus on the issue, or do they have different answers to the underlying problem? For comparative purposes, the speakers will also look at examples outside of the Nordic countries, such as the FIDIC (red book) standard form contract.
