On January 24th 2017 at 14.00 – 17.00 you are invited to a workshop, which will be held in English, with Professor Andrew Robertson, Melbourne Law School. The workshop will take place in “Styrelserummet” in Juridicum.

Professor Robertson is an internationally leading researcher in the fields of civil law and property law, who has previously been a visiting Professor at institutions such as the University of British Columbia and the National University of Singapore. His research covers the law of obligations, contract law and tort law, as well as theoretical and comparative analyses. Andrew Robertson is also the initiator and organizer of the Obligations Conferences series, whose 8th edition will take place at the Melbourne Law School in June 2018 on the theme of “Form and Substance in the Law of Obligations”.

At the workshop Professor Robertson will give an introduction to the subject. After the introduction he, together with Rolf Dotevall Professor in private law at the University of Gothenburg and Per Samuelsson Professor in private law at the University of Lund, will form a panel and there will be a plenary discussion on the entitled subject.
